1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Forest Foun-
5 dation Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL FOREST FOUNDATION ACT REAUTHOR-**
7 **IZATION.**

8 (a) **EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE MATCH-**
9 **ING FUNDS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE AND PROJECT EX-**

1 PENSES.—Section 405(b) of the National Forest Founda-
2 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 583j–3(b)) is amended by striking
3 “for a period of five years beginning October 1, 1992”
4 and inserting “during fiscal years 2016 through 2018”.

5 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
6 410(b) of the National Forest Foundation Act (16 U.S.C.
7 583j–8(b)) is amended by striking “during the five-year
8 period” and all that follows through “\$1,000,000 annu-
9 ally” and inserting “there are authorized to be appro-
10 priated \$3,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2016 through
11 2018”.
